BEGINNERS DOMESTIC DOG TRAINING

(For dogs aged 12 weeks or older)
 Joining fee/membership \$50, plus \$15 concession card for first six weeks of training. Time: 6.30pm. to 7.15pm.
 Includes: heel work, sit and down, stays, recall, socialising etc. Courses are continual. Certificates presented on merit and advancement to next class.

FURTHER TRAINING

Companion / Improvers / Level One Canine Good Citizen classes – 6.30pm to 7.15pm
 These classes are for younger dogs or beginners who are ready for further training and dog socialisation.

Canine Good Citizen classes – 7.30pm to 8.15pm
 Training for dogs (aged over 12 months) and handlers to enable them to cope with everyday situations. These classes lead to Level One, Bronze, Silver and Gold assessments.

Competition Class One – 6.30pm to 7.15pm
 Suitable for dogs and handlers who may like to compete.

Competition Class Two – 7.30pm to 8.15pm
 Suitable for dogs and handlers who are able to compete at Special Beginners level.

Annual subscription renewals – Single \$25 or Family \$30, plus \$3 per night. Concession card for six nights - \$15.

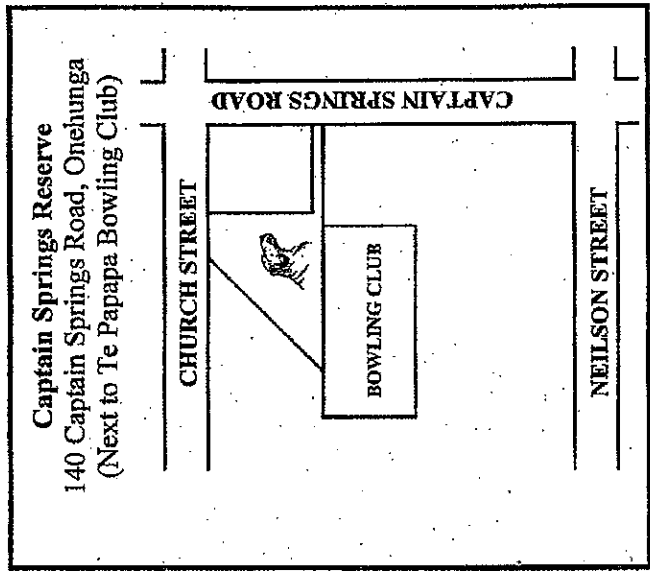

 (No training on statutory holidays.)

All Breeds Dog Training Club, the oldest obedience club in New Zealand, started in 1955. Our instructors are all voluntary, but at the same time have loads of experience between them. They all do, or have done, competition obedience and are all very dedicated.

We train **EVERY MONDAY NIGHT, 6.15 to 9.00pm**, wet or fine. The only exceptions to this are statutory holidays. We have about a month off at Christmas. Arrive around 6.15pm so you can run your dog to toilet, let off steam etc. We have a large area away from the training rings for this.

Do not feed your dog before training.

- It is not good to work your dog on a full stomach.
- It saves you having to clean up the mess.
- If your dog does have an accident, buckets are provided to clean up the mess.

Tea, coffee and biscuits are available in the clubrooms.

Annual membership renewal is due at the end of each financial year. Your membership fees go towards things such as rates, ground maintenance, electricity and other costs incurred with running the club.

I hope you come along and have a look. Just come and watch one night and talk to people. I am sure you will make some friends and the dogs all seem to love it. Believe me, a well trained dog is a pleasure.

WHAT TO WEAR

Shorts, trousers, track pants etc. A skirt is not suitable as it can brush against your dog. Flat shoes, trainers or similar – perhaps gumboots in wet weather, but **NOT** jandals as they are unsafe for training. In cooler weather, a warm jersey and a jacket or waterproof coat.

WHAT YOU NEED

Your dog/puppy, which must have a current vaccination certificate. Please bring this along on your first night for viewing. A plastic bag in case you need to pick up after your dog. A soft webbing or leather lead and a slipchain or collar. A full chain lead is **NOT** suitable. If you are unsure, then please ask your instructor as we have everything you require at the club at reasonable prices.

WHAT YOU GET

These courses require input from you. We show you how and give you advice on handling your dog. We cannot work miracles, but with your enthusiasm and practice you should achieve a reasonable level of competence and have a dog whose behaviour you can be proud of.
